Thank you. **Kwang-Wu Kim** served as president of the Longy School of Music in Cambridge, Massachusetts from 2001-2006. The Longy School of Music, unlike more traditional conservatories, commits itself to preparing musicians to make a difference in the world.

Kim's prior experience includes artistic and administrative director positions with El Paso Pro-Musica and the El Paso Chamber Music Festival, which he cofounded. He has held teaching positions with the Longy School of Music, the University of Texas at El Paso, the Peabody Institute and Dickinson College. Kim holds a doctor of musical arts degree from the Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University and a bachelor's degree in philosophy, magna cum laude, from Yale University.

Kim's other professional activity includes guest faculty and speaking engagements at Stanford University and the Harvard Graduate School of Education, juror and panelist positions with the International Piano Competition for Young Musicians in the Netherlands, the National Association of Schools of Music, and in Boston, at the New England Conservatory, the Boston Conservatory, and the Boston Arts Academy. A student of legendary pianist Leon Fleisher, Kim gave his debut at New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art and was presented at the Marlboro Music Festival by then Artistic Director Rudolf Serkin.

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
