Bob Wilber

Guest Conductor, Soloist and Composer

At 20, Bob was selected to substitute for Sidney Bechet at the first jazz festival at Nice, France, in 1948. In the 1950's, he was leading his own band and playing with Eddie Condon, Bobby Hackett and Benny Goodman. In 1979, *Jazz Journal International* honored him as the Most Acclaimed Musician of the Year.

He was an original member of the World's Greatest Jazz Band led by Bob Haggart and Yank Lawson. As co-leader with Kenny Davern of the Soprano summit, a.k.a. the Summit Reunion, they set new standards by which we judge a small jazz group.

Bob won a Grammy Award in 1986 for his music in the movie "*The Cotton Club.*" His arranging and scoring for the film, "*Bix, An Interpretation of a Legend*" received very high acclaim. Wilber's screen credits also include music he contributed to the "*Untouchables*", "*Tucker*" and "*Brighton Beach Memoirs*."

Oxford University Press has published Wilber's autobiography "Music is not Enough" and in May of 1998 Bob Wilber was awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Music at Hamilton College, Clinton, NY.
